

## Conflict Minerals Statement

Breas Medical Group is dedicated to responsible sourcing and transparency in the use of conflict minerals. In line with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, we work to ensure that our products are free of minerals sourced from conflictaffected regions, including the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries.

Breas Medical Group demand and secure that our suppliers are able to ensure appropriate investigations are exercised to determine the origin and custody of conflict minerals. We rely on the information provided by our suppliers.

Suppliers are expected to align with our sourcing policies and provide Conflict-Free products and components that do not originate from unethical or conflictaffected regions.

All suppliers are required to adhere to Breas' Code of Conduct for Business Partners from Y 2025. From that point onward, Breas will enhance oversight through regular supply chain assessments, including due diligence questionnaires on mineral origins. Non-compliance may result in corrective actions or exclusion from our supply chain to ensure adherence to responsible sourcing standards.

Breas Medical Group remains committed to preventing the distribution of conflict minerals and disclosing mineral origins as necessary to uphold ethical standards. By fostering responsible sourcing and maintaining transparent supplier relationships, we aim to promote sustainability, ethical practices, and social responsibility throughout our global supply chain.

This statement applies to the entire Breas Medical Group and all its legal entities, both domestic and foreign.
