



# Medicare Guidelines for Reimbursement

National Coverage Determination (NCD) for RAD and HMV



### NCD for RAD Devices

FIRST evaluation by end of initial 6-month period

#### Usage criteria:

- At least 4 hours per 24-hour period
- At least 70% of days in a 30-day period

Achieving at least on of these clinical outcomes:

- Normalization (< 46 mmHg) of PaCO2, or
- Stabilization of a rising PaCO2, or
- 20% reduction in PaCO2 from baseline value, or
- Improvement of at least one of the following patient symptoms associated with chronic hypercapnia: headache, fatigue, shortness of breath, confusion, sleep quality

SECOND evaluation between months 7-12

#### Usage criteria:

- At least 4 hours per 24-hour period
- At least 70% of days in each paid rental month

Compliance reports showing same usage criteria must be pulled monthly to qualify for reimbursement

 Includes any month in which accessories / supplies are dispensed

## NCD for HMV

FIRST evaluation by end of initial 6-month period

#### Usage criteria:

- At least 4 hours per 24-hour period
- At least 70% of days in a 30-day period

SECOND evaluation between months 7-12

#### Usage criteria:

- At least 4 hours per 24-hour period
- At least 70% of days in each paid rental month

Compliance reports showing same usage criteria must be pulled monthly to qualify for reimbursement


